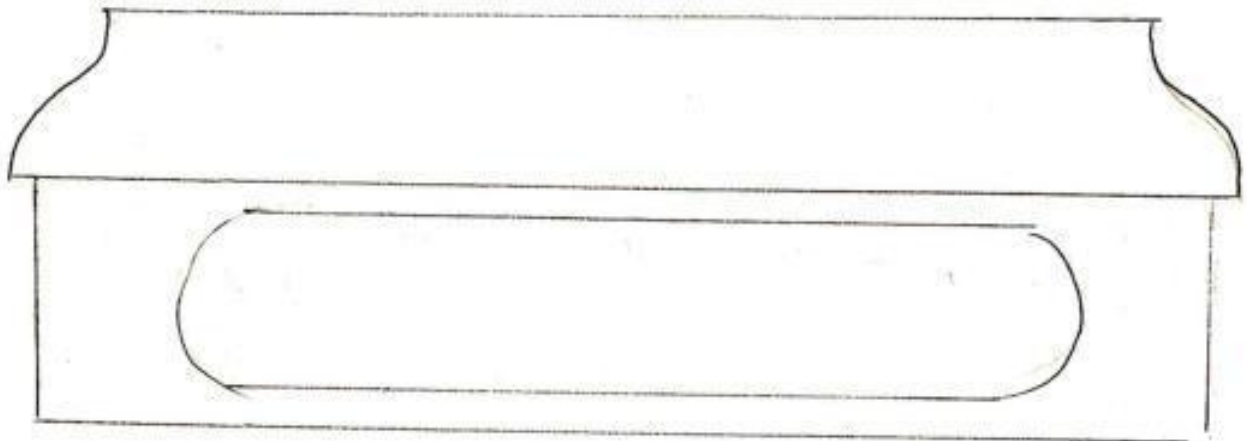
In Memory of THOMAS REYNOLDS
